COMMITMENT: Being appointed a Placer County Youth Commissioner is an honor and a commitment. The community and your fellow commissioners are counting on you. The Commission is much more than putting something on a resume. PCYC forms strong friendships through work that is important, fun, and rewarding. It is important that our expectations are clear from the start. Please initial each of the following sections.

Meetings: 2x a month, 2 hours per meeting

I understand that I am not able to miss meetings without a good excuse. I will send a message to the Vice President and the adult advisor if I am not able to make a meeting. I understand that I need to plan ahead so that studying and school assignments won't be a conflict with PCYC meetings. I realize that missing multiple meetings (even if have given reasons) and not checking in on what I may have missed can lead to my removal from the commission.

Time outside meetings:

In order to contribute and have an impact, work outside of meetings is necessary. I agree that I can find on average an hour a week for PCYC duties. When taking on duties, I agree to complete them according to deadlines. In summary, meeting and outside work totals about 8 hours a month. If I am an officer or leading a project it could be 10 hours a month. I understand that I am expected to attend and participate in special events and activities that PCYC plans. Commissioners are required to attend a minimum of 3 PCYC events throughout the year.

Timely Communication – a Commissioner responsibility:

For group effectiveness, good communication is a necessity. I agree to respond to RSVPs, polls, and to give updates on assignment progress. I will respond within 48 hours to PCYC emails or whatever other communications (Facebook, text, etc.) that the group decides to utilize.
